



## Disposal of the Swiss casino of Crans-Montana

Groupe Partouche announces that it has entered into an agreement to assign all of the 57% of shares it holds in the company Casino de Crans-Montana (Switzerland).

This sale will be finalized by the end of January 2022, providing its approval by the Federal Gaming Commission (CFMJ).

Under the terms of the Group's syndicated loan, the sale of the Crans-Montana casino will contribute either, in part, to the reduction of the Group's financial debt, or to a reinvestment of the sums.

*Groupe Partouche was established in 1973 and has grown to become one of the market leaders in Europe in its business sector. Listed on the stock exchange, it operates casinos, a gaming club, hotels, restaurants, spas and golf courses. The Group operates 42 casinos and employs nearly 4,000 people. It is well known for innovating and testing the games of tomorrow, which allows it to be confident about its future, while aiming to strengthen its leading position and continue to enhance its profitability.*
